WHAT IS YOUTH ENRICHMENT?

The goal of Youth Enrichment is to provide youngsters with an opportunity to participate in academic, athletic and cultural skill building activities that their families might not otherwise be able to afford. These skill building scholarships are aimed at expanding a child's horizons, increasing a child's skills, building self confidence and enhancing self esteem. Students are eligible for three scholarships in a lifetime.

YOUTH ENRICHMENT ELIGIBILITY GUIDELINES

The following factors are considered when determining eligibility to receive a Youth Enrichment Scholarship:

- ◆ The child is a resident of the Waterford School District and is under the age of 17.
- ◆ The child is a client or sibling of a client on the caseload of Waterford Youth Assistance.
- ◆ The child's household income falls within USDA/Section 8 guidelines.
- ◆ The child has a real desire to learn a new skill, but without scholarship support would not otherwise be able to participate.
- ◆ The child's parents willingness to support and participate in the scholarship experience.
